Parent must READ & SIGN before Child is left at school COVID-19 Policies & Procedure

This is our first back-to-school week. Please be patient with us! We will be working on a trial and learn basis. If your child does not return and we have not been in contact with you about discussing your child's spot, we will contact you soon.

- Operating Hours are 6:30 a.m. - 5:30 p.m. All children must be in the Preschool by 10:00. No children will be admitted after this time. We need your cooperation in picking up your children promptly by 5:30 p.m. This has become an issue in the past and we are looking to correct it.
- NO SICK SYMPTOMS ARE ALLOWED! This includes a runny nose with green mucus and/or rashes unless you have a note from the doctor stating non-contagious. Our staff will be wearing masks in the classroom. Please discuss this with your children before they come.
- We are doing our best to minimize the amount of traffic through the school. Therefore, we will be doing front door drop off & pickup only. Please do not form a line at the door. One family at a time come to the door. Our staff will be there at the door to quickly take your children to their classroom. If your child is picked up, they will not be allowed back into the school unless they have a doctor's excuse to return that day. All pickups will begin after 2:00 unless they have a doctor's appointment. You are welcome to call the Preschool 256-298-5045 when you are on your way to make the process go faster.
- Stay in your car if there is someone already at the door so we can maintain a 6-foot distance. Please be patient and kind as everyone is doing their best to be timely and safe. Please allow yourself enough time each morning. This is a work in progress and we are trying diligently to find the best solution.
- Your child's temperature will be taken by staff throughout the day. If your child's fever is 100.0 or higher, has a cough, sore throat, muscle aches or shows signs of difficulty breathing, you will be called to pick them up. If you are contacted, the child MUST be picked up within the hour. Please have a backup plan if you can't come quickly!
- They can only bring one napmat or blanket. No additional naptime comfort items are allowed. Please send extra clothes in a labelled ziplock bag.
- No toys, bags, or backpacks are allowed in the building with your child.
- ALL ACCOUNTS must be up to date. NO PAST DUE ACCOUNTS CAN RETURN THE NEXT WEEK. We are required more staff on the clock with smaller class ratios, we have to have fees paid to stay open.
- Talking between staff and parents will be very minimum at drop-off/pickup for everyone's safety. Please make morning drop off with your child as quick as possible. If you need detailed information, please CALL the center. From this point forward, even after COVID restrictions end, we ask that you refrain from calling/texting staff. With low numbers in summer, not everyone works each day or can have a leave early option. You need to call the preschool and ask to speak to the teacher or someone in charge that day. Everyone needs to keep separate work life from home life and we ask that you respect that and handle all childcare business on the main phone line during business hours to staff and director, unless it is an emergency.
- If you or anyone in your household have been in contact with someone with COVID-19, you must notify the Director immediately.
- Consistent with the COVID-19 policy, if you or anyone in your family have been diagnosed positive, your child will be required to remain out of the building for 14 days.
